As always, thank you for being part of the Senior Connection community. Your kindness, participation, and support continue to drive our mission forward.







**Understanding How They Work & What You Should Know** 

#### **What Are Drug Discount Cards?**

They work like insurance by negotiating lower prices through Pharmacy Benefit Managers (PBMs).

Companies like GoodRx, BlinkRx, and SingleCare are some of the most well-known options.

These companies earn money when you use their card at the pharmacy.

#### **Important Facts:**

- Discount card usage is private, so your insurance company will not be notified.
- Using a discount card will NOT count toward your Medicare Part D \$2,000 cap.
- Only prescriptions filled using your insurance plan will count toward that limit.
- Pharmacies are not required to accept discount cards and can stop accepting a card at any time without warning.
